





60cm high DIY Mesh Guard









Protect plants

1.20m high DIY Mesh Guard












DIY Mesh Guard Assembly Guide





- Plant your tree, shrub or hedging plant (Fig 1).
- Insert stake firmly into the ground next to your plant (Fig 2). Ensure you leave 60cm (or 1.20m depending on the height of your DIY Mesh Guard) above ground.
- Place DIY Mesh Guard against the outside of the stake and attach using a heavy duty staple gun. Staple in the middle first, then bottom, then top (Fig 3).
- Wrap the DIY Mesh Guard around to create a tube, overlapping the stapled end. Staple again in middle first, then bottom, then top (Fig 4).



Tip: Ensure the ridged side of the DIY Mesh Guard is facing outwards - making it easier to create a tube.



Tip: Centre your staple over the mesh grid and the stake to ensure the firmest fix.


